ANNUAL CONCERT SERIES AIMS TO REJUVENATE ST. JAMES PARK

San Jose, CA (September 11th, 2024) - For the fifth year in a row, [The Levitt San Jose](#) free concert series will return to St. James Park in downtown San Jose. The concert series will run every Sunday from 3 pm to 6:30 pm from September 29th until October 20th and will celebrate music from rotating genres with up-and-coming local and national artists - each telling a unique story through song.

The fall concert series is an effort produced by the non-profit, Friends of Levitt San Jose to reimagine St. James Park as a safe gathering space for people of all ages and backgrounds to experience curiosity and joy together through music.

Each Sunday concert will feature a partnership with a local nonprofit foundation in addition to a Beer & Wine Garden, activities for kids, and delicious local food trucks on hand to ensure a stress-free Sunday afternoon getaway in the park.
