
Now, we need a permanent, physical space that will allow us to expand our impact.

















A PUBLIC-PRIVATE PARTNERSHIP

FRIENDS OF LEVITT PAVILION SAN JOSE:


- Lead the capital campaign for the pavilion

- Create meaningful partnerships with local businesses and organizations




THE CITY OF SAN JOSÉ:

IMPACT

Investing in St. James Park's transformation is about more than bricks and mortar.

ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

- Events will draw people downtown, increasing foot traffic and boosting local businesses arts attendees in San José spend an average of \$43.88 per person per event beyond admission, supporting restaurants, shops, and services. (Source: Americans for the Arts Economic Impact Study)
- Proven Economic Growth
 - Levitt Sioux Falls: \$558M in nearby development since 2019
 - Levitt Dayton: \$308M in capital investment since 2018

INVESTMENT & FINANCIAL SUSTAINABILITY

This vision is within reach. We have already secured significant investments in the project:

- The City of San José has already committed \$15 million
- The Levitt Foundation has committed \$535K in seed funding

With your support, we can raise the final \$7 million:

- \$5 million will be devoted to building the Pavilion and will unlock the full funding from the City of San José
- \$2 million will create a multi-year runway for Levitt Pavilion San Jose to implement a proven, sustainable operating model

Friends of Levitt Pavilion San Jose's operating revenue will come from an annual membership program, concessions, venue rentals, foundation support, corporate sponsorships, day-of-show donations, and some ticketed events. A small, year-round staff will keep payroll low, with production contractors hired seasonally for shows.

This is a rare moment where vision, momentum, and resources align. With your partnership, we can turn St. James Park from a forgotten space into the city's cultural anchor.
